New this year, we have the NYDC Junior Membership which is open to all bairns resident in North Yell aged 12-16.

August was the first of the Junior Members Forum. It was very inspiring to get such a passionate group together to discuss what North Yell means to them and plans that they have for the future of their home.

SELLAFIRTH BUSINESS UNITS

Again, as some of you may be aware NYDC are in the process of purchasing 2 units at the Sellafirth Business Park from Global Yell.Again, this has proceeded rather slower than we would have wished, but we are hopeful that the sale will be concluded shortly.

A robust business plan for Sellafirth has been developed, encompassing carbon reducing and renewables projects; economic, social, training,



digitisation and heritage initiatives, and exhibition, performance and retail areas.

NYDC have already submitted funding applications to turn the units into a renewable demonstrator hub, and to establish a digital and oral heritage unit within the building. We will keep you posted on progress.

ELECTRIC MINI BUS

NYDC have purchased an electric minibus as part of a community transport project we are working on with Community Energy Scotland. We are currently in the process of obtaining licences for community use of the vehicle, which we hope to have in place shortly.

GET NORTH YELL GOING AGAIN

Get North Yell Going Again was a 2 year project coordinated by Kate from September 2022- September 2024.This project included Community Lunches, Wicked Wednesdays youth group, prescription and shopping deliveries, community events and day trips, classes and workshops. The project was conceived as a post covid social recovery project to encourage people back out into the community and make social connections.

The project has achieved a great deal over 2 years and we hope that you have managed to make it to some of our events and celebrations be that community lunch on a Tuesday, the Coronation Party at the Hall, the bus trip to Whalsay Charity Shop or our circuits fitness class.

Due to the successes of the Community Lunches and Wicked Wednesday we will continue to seek funding for these projects and if none is available then we keep funding them ourselves.We will also continue providing prescription and shopping deliveries as we feel this is a valuable service to the community. www.northyell.co.uk office@northyell.co.uk kate@northyell.co.uk
